The daycare is thinking about getting a Debit Machine. If you would be interested in using one to pay your childcare bill please let Anna or Erin know.

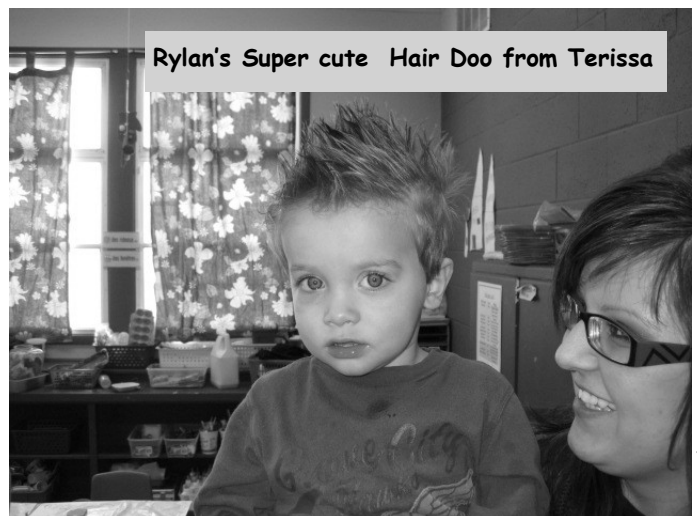
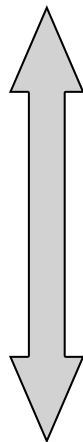
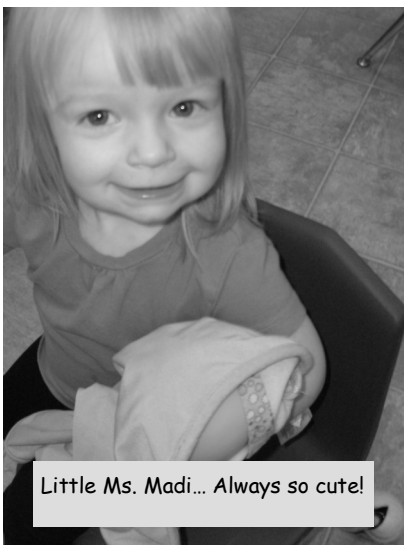
